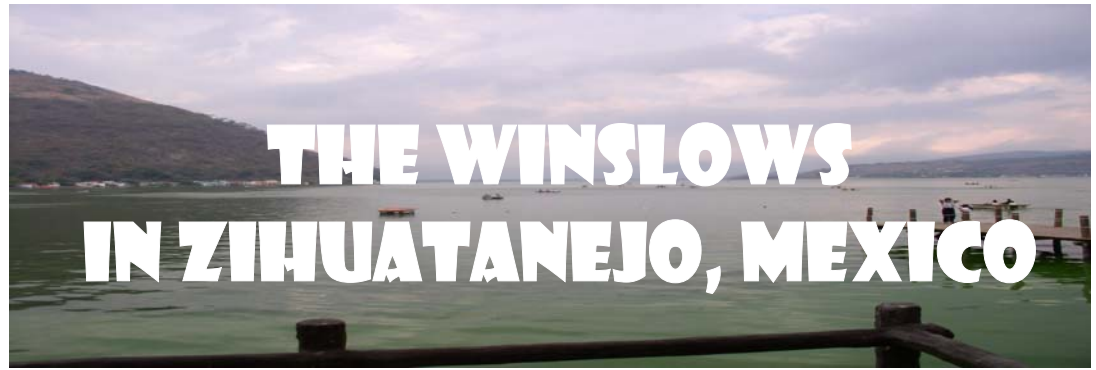


June 2007
